

RFS and HOD actions explained:

ADOPTED	The Assembly adopted the report/resolution as written
NOT ADOPTED	The Assembly voted against adopting the policy/item of business.
REFERRED	The report/resolution was referred to the Governing Council (or AMA Board of Trustees) for further study and report at a subsequent Assembly Meeting. The Governing Council's recommendations will then go to a Reference Committee and be considered by the Assembly.
REFERRED FOR DECISION	The decision as to what action is appropriate is delegated to the AMA-RFS Governing Council, which can take action prior to the next Assembly Meeting.
FILED	This does <u>not</u> imply endorsement or adoption of a policy; it simply indicates that the document (usually an informational report) is <u>received as information</u> and quite literally is "filed."
OTHER	Less common recommendations include postpone consideration, retain, sunset, etc. The latter two bear upon existing AMA-RFS policy, which will be changed and updated by the adoption of a resolution or report.
